CHAP. 40.**Chapter 40.**

An act to incorporate the Orono Manufacturing Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Corporators.

SECT. 1. Courtlandt Palmer, Samuel D. Dakin, and John B. Hill and their associates and successors, are constituted and made

a body politic and corporate by the name of the Orono Manufacturing Company, with all the powers and privileges and subject to

Powers, privileges and liabilities.

all the duties and liabilities provided in the laws of this state concerning manufacturing corporations; and are authorized to purchase

and hold real and personal estate, not exceeding at one time five hundred thousand dollars; and the same to lease, improve, sell and

convey, as other proprietors of real and personal estate may lawfully do; and the said company are authorized to carry on at

Ayer's falls on Penobscot river, in the town of Orono, the manufacture of lumber, and of cotton and woolen goods, and such other

articles and wares, as may be suitably and properly connected therewith; and to erect, purchase, construct and maintain, such

mills, dams, buildings and machinery, as may be useful for that purpose upon their own land. *Provided*, that the running of rafts,

logs, and other lumber shall at all times be as good as the running would be in the natural state of the river, if no dam were erected,

and that a good and sufficient fishway shall be maintained for the free passage of fish around said dam.

Chapter 41.

An act to incorporate the Kenduskeag Bank of Bangor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Corporators.

SECT. 1. Waldo Brown, Waldo T. Pierce, Jabez True, Samuel H. Dale, Isaiah Stetson, Abner Taylor, James Dunning, Dorilus

Morison, Albert Emerson, Thomas A. Taylor, Cyrus Goss, J. B. Foster, George W. Ladd and John McDonald, their associates,

successors and assigns, are hereby incorporated into a company by the name of the president, directors and company of the Kenduskeag Bank of Bangor.

Corporate name.**Capital stock.**

SECT. 2. The capital stock of said bank shall be one hundred thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred dollars each;
