Chapter 94.

CHAP. 94.

An act to incorporate the Megunticook Bank of Camden.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. S. D. Carlton, Robert Chase, Samuel G. Adams, J. C. Stetson, Joseph Jones, Hiram Bass, Abraham Simonton, E. E. Carleton, J. H. Curtis, Benjamin Crabtree, John Glover, John W. K. Norwood, Nelson Pendleton, Ephraim W. Hosmer, Nathaniel Dillingham, Benjamin Cushing, Elijah Glover, Thomas Harback, R. Harkness, Abraham Ogier, Simon Hunt, Alexander Martin, Jotham Shepherd, David Talbot, Austin Sweetland, H. B. Eaton, William Carleton, Comfort Barrows, their associates, successors and assigns, be and hereby are incorporated into a company by the name of president, directors and company of the Megunticook Bank of Camden.

Corporators.

SECT. 2. The capital stock of said bank shall be fifty thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred dollars each, and said bank shall be located and established in Camden, in the county of Waldo.

SECT. 3. Said corporators are hereby authorized and empowered to exercise all the rights and privileges conferred upon such corporations by the laws of this state, and subject to all the liabilities and restrictions thereof; *provided*, said bank shall not go into operation, so as to emit bills, discount notes or make loans, until the first day of October next.

Chapter 95.

An act to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. In order to provide for the operation of certain acts and resolves of the legislature requiring the payment of money from the treasury and also to provide for the necessary expenditures of the government for the current fiscal year, the following sums are hereby appropriated, to be paid out of any moneys in the treasury ; the same being in lieu of all other existing appropriations whatever. And the governor with the advice of the council is hereby authorized at any time prior to the first day of May, eighteen hundred and forty-eight, to draw his warrant upon the treasury for the same.

Appropriation of money for certain purposes.

SECT. 2. The state treasurer is hereby authorized to pay to the legal representatives of Bishop B. Fenwick late of Boston in the state of Massachusetts, deceased, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of four hundred and four dollars and thirty cents if such sum shall be proved to have been paid into the treasury by B. Fenwick by mistake, or which by law he was not bound to pay as a tax assessed on township number two, in the fifth range, west from the east line of the state, and the said proof to be made to the governor and council.
