Chapter 49.

Resolve in favor of Joseph M. Gerrish and William E. Edwards.

Resolved, That there be paid from the treasury of state, to Joseph M. Gerrish and William E. Edwards, the sum of forty-one dollars and sixteen cents in full for publishing the laws of this state for the year eighteen hundred and forty-six.

CHAP. 50.

Chapter 50.

Resolve additional for payment of accounts against the state.

For payment of additional roll of accounts, No. 28.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of any money in the treasury of state not otherwise appropriated, to the several cities, towns, plantations and persons mentioned in the additional roll of accounts numbered twenty-eight, the sum set against the name of such cities, towns, plantations and persons respectively, amounting in the whole to the sum of four thousand seven dollars and seventy-six cents, in full discharge of the claims and demands to which they severally refer.
