#### Chapter 176.

An act to incorporate the Neptune Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Stephen Young, William Bradstreet, Joseph Brad-corporators. SECT. 1. street, Nathaniel Kimball, Nathaniel Stone, James N. Cooper, William Cooper and William Stevens, second, their associates, successors, and assigns, be and hereby are incorporated into a company by the name of the President, Directors, and Company Corporate name. of the Neptune Bank.

SECT. 2. The capital stock of said bank shall be seventy- Capital stock. five thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred dollars each; and said bank shall be located and established in Gardiner in the county of Kennebec.

SECT. 3. The said corporators are hereby authorized and Powers, privite ges and liabiliempowered to exercise all the rights and privileges conferred tios. upon such corporations by the laws of this state, and subject to all the restrictions and liabilities thereof.

#### Chapter 177.

An act to incorporate the Chesuncook Steam Navigation Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sect. 1. Samuel L. Hunt, William Lambert and John D. Corporators Lambert, their associates and assigns, are hereby created a body politic by the name of the Chesuncook Steam Navigation Corporate name. Company, with all the powers and privileges of similar corporations.

The said corporation are hereby authorized to Authorized to SECT. 2. improve the navigation of the west branch of the Penobscot improve the navigation of west river above the Chesuncook lake and also the Umbazookis scot river, &c. stream, to remove any obstructions from said river and stream and to construct and maintain any dam or dams which may be -to croct dams. necessary, and also construct and maintain a steam boat for the -to construct purpose of navigating said Chesuncook lake and said river and steamboat. stream, and shall have the exclusive right of steam navigation Exclusive right on said lake for the term of five years, and the exclusive right tion on said waters, limited. of steam navigation on said river and stream for the term of ten years from the time their steamboat is completed and finished,
