Chapter 176.

CHAP. 176.

An act to incorporate the Neptune Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Stephen Young, William Bradstreet, Joseph Bradstreet, Nathaniel Kimball, Nathaniel Stone, James N. Cooper, William Cooper and William Stevens, second, their associates, successors, and assigns, be and hereby are incorporated into a company by the name of the President, Directors, and Company of the Neptune Bank.

Corporators.

Corporate name.

SECT. 2. The capital stock of said bank shall be seventy-five thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred dollars each ; and said bank shall be located and established in Gardiner in the county of Kennebec.

Capital stock.

SECT. 3. The said corporators are hereby authorized and empowered to exercise all the rights and privileges conferred upon such corporations by the laws of this state, and subject to all the restrictions and liabilities thereof.

Powers, privileges and liabilities.

Chapter 177.

An act to incorporate the Chesuncook Steam Navigation Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Samuel L. Hunt, William Lambert and John D. Lambert, their associates and assigns, are hereby created a body politic by the name of the Chesuncook Steam Navigation Company, with all the powers and privileges of similar corporations.

Corporators

Corporate name.

SECT. 2. The said corporation are hereby authorized to improve the navigation of the west branch of the Penobscot river above the Chesuncook lake and also the Umbazookis stream, to remove any obstructions from said river and stream and to construct and maintain any dam or dams which may be necessary, and also construct and maintain a steam boat for the purpose of navigating said Chesuncook lake and said river and stream, and shall have the exclusive right of steam navigation on said lake for the term of five years, and the exclusive right of steam navigation on said river and stream for the term of ten years from the time their steamboat is completed and finished,

Authorized to improve the navigation of west branch of Penobscot river, &c.

—to erect dams.

—to construct and maintain a steamboat.

Exclusive right of steam navigation on said waters, limited.
