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An act additional to "an act to incorporate the Sabattis Pond and River Comtavo flatic komo con un el comi**pany.!! else 10/610 per 2**4/6

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Damages caused by flowing lands.

Sect. 1. Any person whose lands may be flowed by any dam, which the Sabattis Pond and River Company are authorized by their charter to erect and maintain, shall have his damages ascertained, and compensation shall be made to him therefor, in the manner and under the terms and conditions prescribed in the general laws of this state respecting flowage by mill dams, but this act shall not apply to any complaint, prosecution or action now pending against said company by reason of such flowing.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 188.

An act to provide in part for the expenditures of government.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Appropriations of money for certain purposes.

In order to provide for the operation of certain acts and resolves of the legislature, requiring the payment of money from the treasury and also to provide for the necessary expenditures of government for the current year, the following sums are hereby appropriated to be paid out of any moneys in the treasury; the same to be in lieu of all existing appropriations whatever. And the governor, with the advice and consent of the council, is hereby authorized at any time prior to the first day of May next, to draw his warrant upon the treasurer for the same.

Governor may draw his warrant prior to May 1, 1849
