Chapter 62.

CHAP: 62.

Resolve amending the apportionment resolve of eighteen hundred and forty-two.

Resolved, That the eleventh paragraph of the resolve apportioning one hundred and fifty-one representatives among the several counties, cities, towns, plantations and classes in the state of Maine, approved March seventeenth, eighteen hundred and forty-two, providing that the county of Piscataquis shall choose four representatives, is hereby amended in the fifth line by striking out the word "three" after the word "range," and inserting instead thereof the word "five."

Chapter 63.

Resolve in favor of J. P. Martin.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of this state to J. P. Martin one dollar and thirty-five cents, money paid by him August third, eighteen hundred and forty-seven, for state and county tax assessed on two hundred acres, lot sixty, township number eight, range third, in Aroostook county, the same having been paid by True Green, April sixteenth, eighteen hundred and forty-five, as per treasurer's receipts.

Chapter 64.

Resolve authorizing the treasurer of the county of Aroostook to borrow money.

Resolved, That the treasurer of the county of Aroostook is hereby authorized to procure a loan on the faith and responsibility of said county, of the sum of four thousand and five hundred dollars, at a rate of interest not exceeding six per cent. per annum for the purpose of discharging in part the debts of said county, the interest on said sum to be paid by said county quarter yearly and the principal so borrowed to be reimbursed by said county in five years from the time the same shall be borrowed. And the said treasurer is hereby authorized to give his promissory note therefor as county treasurer for and
