Chapter 89.

CHAP. 89.

Resolve rescinding a resolve approved March twenty-third, eighteen hundred and thirty-eight.

Resolved, That a resolve approved March twenty-third, eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, entitled "resolve in favor of education" is hereby rescinded and annulled.

Chapter 90.

Resolve abating the tax on Number Two, Oxford county, south of Rumford.

Resolved, That the state treasurer is hereby directed to abate the state and county taxes for the years one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, six, seven, and eight, assessed on the aforementioned number two, and he is also directed to charge the county of Oxford, with the amount of county tax abated.

Certain taxes abated.

Chapter 91.

Resolve correcting the valuation of the county of Oxford.

Resolved, That the aggregate valuation of the county of Oxford be four million eighteen thousand thirty-six dollars, instead of the sum now fixed to said county respectively by the resolve approved April fourth, eighteen hundred and forty-five. The above abatement is by reason of number two south of Rumford, being incorporated into two plantations by the names of Franklin and Milton.

Chapter 92.

Resolve in favor of the trustees of Somerset Academy.

Resolved, That the land agent of this state is hereby authorized and directed to convey to the trustees of Somerset Academy, one quarter township of land situated in the county of
