CHAP. 111.**Chapter 111.**

Resolve for the payment of certain accounts against the state.

Town of Bloom-
field.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of any money in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of forty-three dollars and sixty cents, for the payment of the following account, in full discharge of the claims and demands to which they severally refer, namely: to the town of Bloomfield, for bounty on silk, eleven dollars and eighty-five cents; to the town of Ellsworth, for bounty on animals, ten dollars; to the town of Cooper, for bounty on animals, eight dollars; to the publishers of the Bangor Gazette, for publishing the laws of eighteen hundred and forty-seven, thirteen dollars and seventy-five cents.

Chapter 112.

Resolve respecting the state paper.

Copy of State pa-
per required to be
furnished clerks
of judicial courts.
Duty of clerks.

Resolved, That the publisher of the state paper is required to forward one copy of the said paper regularly to the clerk of the judicial courts in each county in the state, and it shall be the duty of the several clerks faithfully to preserve and file such papers, for the inspection of the public.

Chapter 113.

Resolve making an appropriation for the Insane Hospital.

\$10,000 appropri-
ated.
How expended.

Resolved, That there be appropriated and paid out of the state treasury the sum of ten thousand dollars; the same to be expended (or as much thereof as will be necessary) under the direction of the trustees of the insane hospital, in finishing and completing the new wing of said hospital.
