Chapter 122.

Resolve laying a tax on the several counties in this state.

Resolved, That the sums annexed to the counties contained in the following schedule, are hereby granted as a tax for each county respectively, to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied for the purpose of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same and other purposes ordered by law, to wit:

County taxes.
York, twelve thousand five hundred dollars ;
Lincoln, sixteen thousand five hundred dollars ;
Hancock, six thousand five hundred dollars ;
Washington, seven thousand dollars ;
Kennebec, thirteen thousand six hundred and fifty dollars ;
Oxford, nine thousand dollars ;
Somerset, six thousand six hundred dollars ;
Penobscot, fourteen thousand dollars ;
Waldo, eight thousand three hundred and fifty dollars ;
Piscataquis, three thousand five hundred dollars ;
Franklin, three thousand two hundred dollars ;
Aroostook, two thousand one hundred and sixty dollars.
