This resolve shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 142.

Resolves making an appropriation for the improvement of the public grounds.

Resolved, That there be appropriated and paid out of the state treasury the sum of four hundred dollars to be expended under the direction of the governor and council in improvements on the public grounds. \$400 to be expended under direction of governor and council.

Resolved, That the governor and council be authorized and directed to expend any sum that may accrue from the sale of grass, on the public grounds, in improving the same. Proceeds of the sale of grass.

Chapter 143.

Resolve in favor of Nicholas Pierce.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of state to Nicholas Pierce of Limerick, the sum of fifty-two dollars per year, for the term of five years from the tenth day of February last, the same being a pension for an injury sustained by him while on military duty. Pension of \$52 per annum, for five years.

Chapter 144.

Resolve in favor of Joseph Lolah Salmo.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of this state to Joseph Lolah Salmo the sum of forty-five dollars, it being to remunerate him for expenses incurred in traveling to \$45, remuneration for expenses incurred, as agent of his tribe.
