CHAP. 178.

Chapter 178.

Resolve in favor of the trustees of Somerset Academy.

Land agent directed to convey to trustees quarter township of land.

Value.

Proviso.

Resolved, That the land agent of this state is hereby authorized and directed to convey to the trustees of Somerset Academy, one quarter township of land situated in the county of Aroostook, said land to be selected by the land agent, and to be equal in value, as near as may be, to one half of the east half of township number three, in the fourth range of townships in the county of Aroostook; the land agent in estimating the value of the land to be granted, shall have reference to the value of the above named land at the time it was conveyed to the trustees of the Lee Normal School: *provided, however*, that the land agent shall not make the conveyance herein provided, unless he shall be fully satisfied, on or before the first Monday of October next, that the trustees applying for such grant shall have furnished a good academical building; shall have commenced a school in said building, and shall have corporate property at least to the amount of thirteen hundred dollars over and above the debts of the corporation.

Chapter 179.

Resolve in favor of Dependence Doughty.

Grant of land.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized and directed to convey to Dependence Doughty lot numbered four in township numbered thirteen, range six, west from the east line of the state.

Chapter 180.

Resolve providing for the repair of the Baring and Houlton road in the Orient.

Land agent authorized to expend \$100.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to expend a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars in repairing the Baring and Houlton road, in the tract of land called the Orient, in the county of Aroostook.
