1849.

Chapter 193.

Resolve for the payment of certain accounts against the state.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of three hundred and twenty-five dollars, for the payment of the following accounts in full discharge of the claims and demands to which they severally refer, namely: to the city of Bangor, two hundred and eighty-six dollars, for the support of certain persons at the insane hospital; to the town of Fairfield ten dollars for bounty on animals; to Wendall P. Smith, sheriff of Cumberland county, twenty-nine dollars, for distributing blanks and tax warrants for the years eighteen hundred and forty-seven, and eighteen hundred and forty-eight and eighteen hundred and forty-nine.

Chapter 194.

CHAP. 194.

Resolve for payment of additional roll of accounts number thirty.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of any money in the treasury of state, not otherwise appropriated, to the several persons, cities, towns and plantations respectively named in the additional roll of accounts numbered thirty, the sums set against the names of such persons, cities, towns and plantations, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of five thousand two hundred fifty-one dollars and sixty-eight cents, in full discharge of the claims and demands to which they severally refer.

Chapter 195.

Resolve in relation to the sale of certain state lands.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby directed to sell for cash, at public auction, on the townships, on or before the first day of December next, all the unsold lots in township number four in the fifth range, west from the east line of the state; and also the unsold lots in township number eleven range five; *provided*, in the opinion of the said agent, the sale of the lots in the last named township would be for the interest of the state. The sales aforesaid to be in lots not exceeding six hundred and forty acres, and at a price not less than a minimum, to be fixed by the land agent; and the land agent is directed to publish notice of said sales in some one of the weekly newspapers printed in Bangor, Portland and Augusta, the same to be inserted three times, thirty days before the time of sale.

Land agent authorized to sell certain lands.

Lots not to exceed 640 acres.
