CHAP. 214.**Chapter 214.**

Resolve in favor of Columbus Dunn.

In favor of Co-
lumbus Dunn.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to convey to Columbus Dunn of Amity, lot number thirty-three in said town, when he shall produce satisfactory evidence that he or his father, Jonah Dunn, have paid the original contract price of said lot, either in money or labor on the road.

Resolve in favor of the town of Passadumkeag.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be authorized and directed to deliver to the town of Passadumkeag one copy of all the acts, resolves, laws, reports, maps and revised statutes, to replace the losses of said town by fire ; providing the same can be spared from the library.

Resolve regulating the salary of the adjutant general.

Salary of adju-
tant general, in-
creased.

Resolved, That in addition to the salary allowed the adjutant general by the act of August tenth, eighteen hundred and forty-eight, there be annually allowed and paid said officer from any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of one hundred dollars, in full satisfaction for personal services and for clerk hire.
