#### Chapter 306.

Sept. HALLAND L

Снар. 306.

An act extending the time allowed the Mousam Navigation Company to complete their improvements.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

A further time of five years from the twentieth day of July, eighteen hundred and fifty-one, is hereby allowed to the Mousam Navigation Company to complete their improvements: provided, that nothing herein contained shall operate to extend the time said company shall enjoy the exclusive privileges granted in the act establishing said company.

#### Chapter 307.

An act to incorporate the trustees of the "East Maine Conference Seminary."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Asahel Moore, William H. Pilsbury, William G. Corporators. Chase, John Atwell, Sylvanus Rich, Joseph Doane, William Marsh, Charles Beale, Benjamin Bryant, Henry M. Blake, Joseph Cargill, Henry C. Lowell, Cyrus Scammon, Seth H. Beale, Horace Muzzey, George Pratt, Albert Church, R. A. Ricker, John A. Jarvis, Micah J. Talbot, Sullivan Bray, Theophilus Doe, Caleb D. Pilsbury and Mark R. Hopkins, with their associates and successors, are hereby constituted a corporation by the name of "Trustees of the East Maine Conference Corporate name. Seminary," for the promotion of literature, science, good government and morality.

SECT. 2. Said corporation may have a common seal; may sue and be sued; make such by-laws not repugnant to the laws of this state, as they may deem expedient for the management of their affairs; remove any of their number whom they shall deem incapable of discharging said trust; fill all vacancies, occurring by such removal, or otherwise, and choose additional trustees: provided however, that the number of said trustees Provise. shall never exceed twenty-seven.

SECT. 3. Said trustees are also hereby authorized to take and hold estate, real and personal, that they may now possess, take and hold real estate or hereafter receive, by donation or otherwise, the annual income of which shall not exceed three thousand dollars; and are
