CHAP. 326.Not entitled to
any money, 1850.

SECT. 5. Said north society shall not be entitled to any moneys due from the state for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty.

Chapter 326.

An act to incorporate the Exchange Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Corporators.

SECT. 1. John B. Foster, J. S. Wheelwright, Sidney Thaxter, Charles Hayward, Ephraim Paulk, Cyrus Goss, Isaac A. Hatch, Albert Smith, James Dunning, M. L. Appleton, their associates, successors and assigns are hereby incorporated into a company by the name of the president, directors and com-

pany of the Exchange Bank.

Capital stock.

SECT. 2. The capital stock of said bank shall be fifty thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred dollars each, and said bank shall be located and established in Bangor, in the county of Penobscot.

Rights, privi-
leges, &c.

SECT. 3. Said corporators are hereby authorized and empowered to exercise all the rights and privileges conferred upon such corporations by the laws of this state and shall be subject to all the liabilities and restrictions thereof.

Chapter 327.

An act to incorporate the Merchants' Bank of Bangor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :
