Chapter 247.

Resolve in favor of Gould's Academy in Bethel.

Resolved, That the land agent of this state is hereby author- Grant of land. ized and directed to convey to the trustees of Gould's Academy in Bethel, one half township of land to be selected by the land agent, from the land now held in severalty by this state.

Chapter 248.

Resolve granting to Alphonso Rogers a lot of settling land.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to make Grant of land. and execute to Alphonso Rogers, and Huldah Rogers, wife of said Alphonso, both of township letter D, range one, county of Aroostook, a deed of lot numbered one hundred and thirtyfour, range one, in said letter D township.

Chapter 249.

Resolve in favor of Oliver L. Currier and Oliver R. Merrill.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the state to Oliver L. Currier one hundred and twenty dollars, for his services in preparing a new bill of the school laws, as required by a resolve of the legislature approved July twentysixth, eighteen hundred and forty-nine; and to Oliver R. Merrill thirty dollars, for his services in transcribing said bill.

Chapter 250.

Resolve in favor of William Emerson.

Resolved, That the state treasurer be, and he hereby is, authorized to deliver up to William Emerson of Bangor, and cancel, three promissory notes, signed by said Emerson, for two thousand dollars each, dated August tenth, eighteen hundred
