CHAP. 341. inhabitants interested in said bridge shall contribute such further sum as may be necessary to complete the construction of said bridge.

**Chapter 341.**

Resolve in favor of the Baring and Houlton road.

Baring and

*Resolved,* That the land agent be and he is hereby authorized to expend one hundred and fifty dollars in repairing the Baring and Houlton road, one hundred thereof to be expended in township number eleven, at the monument, and the balance in Orient.

[Approved August 29, 1850.]
