Chapter 343.

Resolve to amend the state valuation for the county of Penobscot.

Resolved, That the resolve establishing a valuation for the State of Maine, passed August twenty-eighth, eighteen hundred and fifty, be amended by striking out the footing of the aggregate valuation of the several towns in Penobscot county, to wit, the figures eight million, nine hundred fifty-three thousand, one hundred and forty, and inserting in their stead the figures eight million, nine hundred fifty thousand, one hundred and forty, and also, by striking out the footing of the aggregate valuation of the wild lands in said county, to wit, the figures one hundred forty-one thousand, three hundred and twenty-five and inserting in their stead the figures one hundred forty-five thousand, eight hundred and twenty-five, so that in the resolve as amended, the footing first above named shall read eight million, nine hundred fifty thousand one hundred and forty dollars, and the footing last above named shall read one hundred forty-five thousand eight hundred and twenty-five.
