Chapter 377.

CHAP. 377.

Resolve for the payment of additional roll of accounts, No. 32, for 1851.

Resolved, That there be paid from the treasury of the state, out of any money not otherwise appropriated, to the several persons, towns and cities mentioned in the additional roll of accounts number thirty-two, the sums set against their names respectively, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one hundred forty-eight dollars, and thirty-eight cents, in full discharge of the accounts and demands to which they severally refer.

Chapter 378.

Resolve in favor of Horace B. Prescott and Henry Young.
