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## Chapter 457.

An act to set off the farm of Elisha James from Mercer to Norridgewock.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The farm of Elisha James now situated in the town of Mercer, is hereby set off from said town and annexed to the town of Norridgewock.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governer.

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## Chapter 458.

An act to authorize the laying out of a road over tide waters in the town of Topsham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The county commissioners of the county of Lincoln, or the selectmen of the town of Topsham, are hereby authorized, if they deem it expedient, to lay out and establish a public highway in said town of Topsham across the Muddy river, at or
