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Chapter 457.

An act to set off the farm of Elisha James from Mercer to Norridgewock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The farm of Elisha James now situated in the Elisha James SECT. 1. set off to Nortown of Mercer, is hereby set off from said town and annexed ridgewock. to the town of Norridgewock.

This act shall take effect and be in force from SECT. 2. and after its approval by the governer.

Chapter 458.

An act to authorize the laying out of a road over tide waters in the town of Topsham.
