Chapter 556.

An act to incorporate the Somerset Manufacturing Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Jotham Hobbs, Aaron G. Starbird, Elbridge G. Corporators. SECT. 1. Rideout, Lorenzo D. Colcord, Simon Pierce, Wentworth Varnev, George H. Quimby, Winslow Marston, Joseph Marston and Lemuel Shepard, their associates and successors are hereby constituted and made a body politic and corporate by the name of the Somerset Manufacturing Company, for the purpose of Corporate manufacturing lumber, grain, iron, wool, cotton and for any other purpose for which water power may be used, at the place called Somerset mills in the town of Fairfield, with all the powers and privileges and subject to all duties and liabilities provided by the laws of this state concerning manufacturing corporations. And said corporation is authorized to purchase and hold real and personal estate to the amount of fifty thousand dollars, and may erect or purchase such buildings, dams, and machinery as may be necessary for the purposes aforesaid, at the place aforesaid, and may improve, lease or sell the same as other owners of property may lawfully do.

SECT. 2. Any three of the persons named in the first sec- First meeting. tion of this act may call the first meeting of this corporation by publishing in the "Eastern Mail" notice thereof, at least fourteen days before the time of the meeting.
