Chapter 380.

Resolve in favor of Spencer G. Bowes.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of the state to Spencer G. Bowes, four dollars per month for five years from the first day of January, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two, for an injury received while in the service of the state. Pension.

Chapter 381.

Resolve in favor of the town of Ellsworth.

Whereas, the town of Ellsworth has lost by fire, which occurred in December eighteen hundred and forty-nine, certain copies of the public and private acts and resolves and reports of the state, allowed them by law ; therefore Acts, resolves, &c., to furnish the town of Ellsworth.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be and he is hereby authorized to supply said town with such numbers of said acts, resolves and reports as he may be satisfied were lost.
