Chapter 399.

Resolve for the payment of additional roll of accounts, number thirty-two.

Payment of
accounts
against the
state.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of any money in the treasury of state, not otherwise appropriated, to the several persons, cities, towns and plantations, respectively named in the additional roll of accounts, number thirty-two, the sums set against the names of such persons, cities, towns and plantations, amounting in the aggregate, to the sum of eleven thousand and ninety-eight dollars and thirteen cents in full discharge of all the claims and demands to which they severally refer.
