**Chapter 438.**

Resolve for payment of accounts against the state.

Payment of accounts, &c.

*Resolved,* That there be paid from the treasury of the state out of money not otherwise appropriated, to the several persons, towns and plantations, mentioned in the third additional roll of accounts numbered thirty-two, the sum set against their names respectively, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one thousand, eight hundred and seventy-eight dollars and ninety-five cents in full discharge of the accounts and demands to which they severally refer.
