Chapter 439.

CHAP. 439.

Resolve in favor of Ebenezer Taylor.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to abate the amount due the state in labor on lot numbered seventy-four in township letter H, in the county of Aroostook, and to convey the same to said Taylor.

Resolve for the Repair of the state arsenal at Bangor.

Resolved, That for the purpose of the repair of the state arsenal at Bangor, there is hereby appropriated the sum of two thousand dollars to be expended under the direction of the adjutant general.

Resolve in favor of Zebulon Ingersoll.

Resolved, That the land agent be and he hereby is authorized to refund to Zebulon Ingersoll the amount paid by him to this state for timber cut upon the lands of Massachusetts, not exceeding two hundred and ninety-one dollars.

Amount paid for timber refunded.

Resolve in favor of Joseph Hodge.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby directed to convey to Joseph Hodge of Minot, lot number thirty-six in township number three, Indian Purchase (the certificate by which said lot was drawn, having been lost) or if the said lot has been conveyed by the state, then to convey to said Hodge some other lot similar in value.

Land conveyed.
