Chapter 44.

CHAP. 44.

An act to incorporate the Ship Builders' Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Henry C. Lowell, George Thomas, Horace Mariam, Corporators. William L. Pitts, John S. Coburn, John Spear, Israel Snow, B. W. Lothrop, George S. Wiggin, F. W. Rhodes, Henry Ingraham, A. G. Luce, John Bird, Alden Ulmer, B. W. Sawyer and Thomas Colson, of Rockland, George Thorndike and Charles McLoon, of South Thomaston, in the State of Maine, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby incorporated into a company by the name of the President, Directors and Company of the Corporate Ship Builders' Bank.

SECT. 2. The capital stock of said bank shall be one hundred Capital stock. thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred dollars each, said bank to be located in Rockland, in the county of Lincoln.

SECT. 3. Said corporators are hereby authorized and empowered to exercise all the rights and privileges conferred upon such corporations by the laws of this state, and shall be subject to all the liabilities and restrictions thereof.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.
