CHAP. 14.**Chapter 14.**

Resolve to aid the Passamaquoddy Indians to finish houses and barns.

Buildings, aid
in erection
of, &c.

Resolved, That whenever any Indian belonging to said tribe, shall at his or her own expense, erect on the Indian townships, a suitable frame for a house or barn, or both, the agent of said Indians be and he hereby is authorized to furnish for each of said Indians who has so erected such frame or frames, boards, shingles or clapboards, and nails sufficient to cover said frames so erected; and that the expense of furnishing said lumber and nails be charged to the Indian fund, said agent to account for his doings in the premises, and to be under the direction of the governor and council.

Chapter 15.

Resolve in favor of R. B. Jennings.

Transporta-
tion of
ordnance.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the state treasury to R. B. Jennings thirty-six dollars seventy-two cents, being for expenses incurred by him for the transportation of ordnance from Portland to Buckfield, and for four casks of powder for experimental gunnery, and for storage.

Chapter 16.

Resolve for the payment of roll of accounts, number thirty-three.

Payment of.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of any money in the treasury of state, not otherwise appropriated, to the several persons, towns and plantations respectively named in the roll of accounts, number thirty-three, the sum set against the names of such persons, towns and plantations, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of three thousand five hundred seven-teen dollars and eighty-eight cents, in full discharge of all the claims and demands to which they severally refer.
