Resolve in favor of certain persons of the legislature who visited the state prison.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of the state Committee of the following sums, viz: to James Walker, eight dollars and eighty-three cents; to Seth O'Brien, eight dollars and eighty- pay of three cents; to Thomas Erskine, eight dollars and eighty-three cents, members of the legislature, appointed to visit the state prison by an order passed March twelfth, eighteen hundred and fifty-three.
