# STATE OF MAINE.

#### Chapter 58.

An act to change the time of holding the April term of the court of county commissioners for the county of Washington.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows: A constraint office

SECT. 1. The court of county commissioners for the county Court of county of Washington, shall be holden at Machias, in said county, on Washington county, April the first Wednesday next after the fourth Tuesday of April, torm. annually, instead of the first Wednesday next after the first Tuesday of April, as now provided by law.

SECT. 2. All matters and things returnable to and which Matters and would, but for the provisions of this act, have day at the term things returnof said court, provided to be held in said county, on the first Wednesday next after the first Tuesday of April next, shall be returnable to, and have day at the term of said court to be held on the first Wednesday next after the fourth Tuesday of April next.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

#### Chapter 59.

An act to change the time of holding the April term of the supreme judicial court, in the county of Washington.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The supreme judicial court shall be holden on the fourth Tuesday of April, annually, at Machias, within and for Washington the county of Washington, instead of the first Tuesday of April, as prescribed by section fifteenth, of "An act concerning the supreme judicial court and its jurisdiction," approved April ninth, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two.

All matters and things returnable to, and which Matters and SECT. 2. would, but for the provisions of this act, have day at the term able, &c. of said court, provided to be held, in said county, on the first Tuesday of April next, shall be returnable to, and have day at the term of said court to be held on the fourth Tuesday of April next.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.
