PRIVATE AND SPECIAL LAWS

OF THE

STATE OF MAINE.

SECT. 4. Said corporation shall have power to hold real and CHAP. 237. personal property, not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, and its capital stock, not exceeding said sum, may be divided into such number of shares as its by-laws shall provide.

May hold real and personal

SECT. 5. The first meeting of said corporation may be called First meeting. by any three of the corporators herein named, by causing an advertisement of the time and place and purposes thereof to be published in one of the newspapers published in Bath two weeks successively before the time of meeting.

This shall take effect as soon as it shall be approved by the governor.

Chapter 237.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The president, directors and company of the cor- Capital stock poration entitled the Atlantic Ship Wharf and Lime Manufac- s50,000. turing Company, incorporated by an act of the legislature passed March eighteenth, one thousand eight hundred and fiftythree, and approved by the governor March nineteenth, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-three, are hereby authorized to increase the capital stock of said company by adding thereto the sum of fifty thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of one hundred dollars each; to be invested, applied and used for the purposes named in the original act of incorporation.
