Chapter 90.

Resolve authorizing the county of Washington to procure a loan.

Resolved, That the treasurer of the county of Washington is hereby authorized to procure a loan on the faith and responsibility of said county, of a sum not exceeding twelve thousand dollars, at a rate of interest not exceeding six per cent. per annum, for the purpose of discharging the liabilities of said county in the erection of its county buildings. The interest on said sum to be paid annually, and the principal to be reimbursed by said county at such time or times as the county commissioners may agree upon: *provided*, the whole sum shall be paid within twelve years; and the said treasurer is hereby authorized to give his promissory note or notes therefor as county treasurer for and in behalf of said county, payable in the manner aforesaid.
