#### Chapter 124.

#### Resolve in favor of Thomas S. Roberts.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized to convey to Thomas S. Roberts two hundred acres of land on any state township set apart and lotted for settlement. October tain lands to. twenty-first, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty; to be selected by said Roberts; provided, the selection is made Proviso. and notice thereof given to the land agent within one year from the date of this resolve; the same to be in full for said Roberts' elaim, under resolve approved July twenty-six in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty.

#### Chapter 125.

#### Resolve in aid of road in the county of Somerset.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to expend the Road from sum of five hundred dollars in repairing the road leading from the town of Lexington to Flagstaff township in the county of Somerset.

#### Chapter 126.

#### Resolve in aid of roads in the county of Aroostook.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to expend the Road from Fort sum of five hundred dollars to repair the road leading from Allegash river, Fort Kent to the mouth of the Allegash river; provided, the Proviso. inhabitants of Hancock plantation appropriate and expend a like sum in a manner acceptable to the land agent, by the first day of September next.
