Resolve in favor of John A. Poor.

Resolved, That the governor and council be authorized to audit the claim of John A. Poor of the State of Maine, for services by him rendered as agent for the state in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two, under the direction of the governor and council; and that the governor with the advice of the council be authorized to draw his warrant on the treasury for such amount as may be found due; to be paid out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
