Resolve in favor of W. E. Hilton.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of the state out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated to W. E. Hilton the sum of six dollars for publishing laws of the extra session.

Resolve in favor of George Savage.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury of this state to George Savage the sum of fifty dollars in consequence of an injury this day sustained while employed in the service of the state.

Chapter 181.

Resolve in favor of Honorable Elisha Clarke.

Elisha Clarke, in favor of.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury to Elisha Clarke, fifteen dollars for expenses incurred by sickness during the session of the legislature for the year eighteen hundred fifty-three.
