Resolve for purchasing six copies of Colton's Map of New England and British Provinces, fifty-six by sixty-four inches.

Colton's maps,  
for purchase of.

*Resolved,* That the secretary of state be directed to purchase six copies of Colton's map of New England and the British provinces, and place one in the council chamber, one in the hall of the house of representatives, one in the senate chamber, one in the state treasurer's office, one in the secretary of state's office, and one in land office in Bangor, and that the governor be authorized to draw his warrant for the payment of the same out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
