Chapter 114.

An act to amend the thirty-eighth section of the one hundred and fourth chapter of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The thirty-eighth section of the one hundred and Chap. 104, sec. SECT. 1. fourth chapter of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "declaration," in the fourth line, the word "citation," so that the section as amended shall read as follows:

No sheriff, deputy sheriff, or constable, shall be Sheriffs, &c., not SECT. 38. suffered to appear before any court, or justice of the peace, as attorney to, or in behalf of, or assisting, or advising any party in a suit, nor be allowed to draw any writ, plaint, declaration, citation, or process, or plea, for any other person; and all such acts, done by -acts of, void. either of them, shall be void.

Chapter 115.

An act to amend chapter two hundred and forty-four of the public laws of the year eighteen hundred and fifty-two.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The third section of an act, being chapter two hundred and forty- Discretionary four of the public laws, passed in the year eighteen hundred and approved by probate court, fifty-two, approved on the ninth day of April of that year, is hereby rescinded. repealed.
