Chapter 119.

An act repealing chapter twenty-eighth of public laws, approved March twenty-ninth, eighteen hundred and fifty-three.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The act prescribing the time when notice shall be Notice upon peti-SECT. 1. tions for special given upon petitions for special legislation, passed and approved legislation. Act preserving twenty-ninth of March, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, is hereby the time of, repealed. repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 120.

An act making further provision for the conveyance of property of married women.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any married woman, seized and possessed, in her own Married women SECT. 1. right, of any real estate, situated within this state, or of any personal property, shall have power to lease, sell, convey and dispose of the same, or any part thereof, by her separate deed, in her own name, as if she were unmarried; and no action shall be maintained No action to be by the husband of any such married woman, or by any person husband. claiming, under or through him, for the possession or value of any property held or disposed of by her, as aforesaid.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts, inconsistent herewith, are Inconsistent acts hereby repealed; and this act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 121.
