Chapter 402.

An act to amend "An act respecting the erection of wooden buildings in the city of Portland," approved April first, eighteen hundred fifty-four.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The first section of said act is hereby amended by striking out the words "ten feet in height from the ground to the eaves of the roof," and inserting the following: "thirteen feet high from the sill to the plate, with a foundation not exceeding three feet above the highest side of the ground upon which the building is to be erected."

Buildings, height of, regulated.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force in and after four months from its approval by the governor.

[Approved January 19, 1855.]
