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**Chapter 449.****CHAP. 449.**

An act in addition to an act entitled "An act to incorporate the Mechanics' Bank," approved April eighteenth, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECT. 1. The time allowed for putting the Mechanics' Bank in operation is hereby extended to the first day of October next.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.

**Chapter 450.**

An act to incorporate the Hiram Dale Manufacturing Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECT. 1. Hiram E. Pierce, David Pierce, junior, and John Pierce, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby incorporated and constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name of the Hiram Dale Manufacturing Company, for the purpose of manufacturing wool, cotton, iron, wood, leather, cordage or painted carpets or paper, in the city of Belfast, in the county of Waldo; and said corporation shall have power to erect all necessary dams and buildings on their own land, as may be required for said purposes, and may hold real and personal estate to the value of one hundred thousand dollars, with power to divide the same into stock, in shares of not less than fifty or more than one hundred dollars, and shall be subject to all the liabilities, and clothed with such powers, as such companies are now by law subject to, and clothed.
