for such sums as may be necessary to execute the purpose of this
resolve.

Chapter 249.

Resolve to correct the state valuation of the town of Belmont, and to establish that of
the town of Morrill.

Resolved, That the sum of sixty-two thousand six hundred and
eight dollars, for estate, and one hundred and twenty polls be de-
ducted from the valuation of the town of Belmont, and added to the
town of Morrill, so that the state valuation of Belmont shall stand
sixty-two thousand six hundred and seven dollars, for estate, and
one hundred and twenty-one polls; and the state valuation of Mor-
rill shall be sixty-two thousand six hundred and eight dollars, for
estate, and one hundred and twenty polls; and the treasurer of
state is required to correct the tax for the year eighteen hundred
and fifty-five, and each succeeding year until a new state valuation
is made, and issue his warrants accordingly.

Chapter 250.

Resolves in relation to the payment of the state debt.

Resolved, That the land agent be directed to collect from the
securities in the land office, the amount due on state scrip, in March,
eighteen hundred and fifty-six, being one hundred and thirty-two
thousand five hundred dollars, and pay over to the treasurer of the
state, from time to time, such amounts as he may receive therefrom.

Resolved, That the treasurer of state be directed to apply so
much of the said proceeds as may not be otherwise appropriated, to
the purchase of the scrip of the state, due in March, eighteen hun-
dred and fifty-six, as aforesaid, if such scrip can be obtained at par;
if not thus obtained, to the payment of the public debt, due as
aforesaid.
