Chapter 262.

Resolve for the payment of additional roll of accounts, number thirty-five.

Payment of additional roll of accounts No. 35.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of any money in the treasury of state, not otherwise appropriated, to the several persons, cities, towns and plantations, respectively named in the additional roll of accounts, numbered thirty-five, the sum set against the names of such persons, cities, towns and plantations, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of four thousand four hundred seventynine dollars and ninety-one cents, in full discharge of the claims and demands to which they severally refer.

Chapter 263.

Resolve for the encouragement of flax growing.

Flax growing, encouragement Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars is hereby placed in the hands of the Maine State Agricultural Society, for the encouragement of the raising of flax in this state, to be appropriated in such manner as in their judgment will best subserve such purpose. And the governor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the treasury for the same.
