Chapter 190.

An act to repeal an act entitled "An act regulating the suffrage of naturalized citizens."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The act entitled "An act regulating the suffrage of naturalized citizens," approved March seventeenth, eighteen hundred and fifty-five, is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 191.

An act to repeal an act entitled "An act annulling the naturalization powers of courts in this state."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The act entitled "An act annulling the naturalization powers of courts in this state," approved March sixteenth, eighteen hundred and fifty-five, is hereby repealed.
