Chapter 539.

An act additional to "An act to incorporate the Calais Gas Light Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Calais Gas Light Company are hereby aucration of thorized to extend their gas pipes to the line of the state, and to connect the same with the pipes of any gas company which connection may be established in Saint Stephen, in the Province of New Brunswick.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

Chapter 540.

An act granting further powers to the proprietors of Forest Grove Cemetery.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The Proprietors of Forest Grove Cemetery are Authorized to hereby empowered to take and hold a further amount of land, amount of real not exceeding twelve acres, for the purposes of their cemetery and personal estate.
