Chapter 679.

An act to amend the act to incorporate the Oxford Agricultural Aid Society.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Shares, par

SECT. 1. The stock of this corporation shall be divided into shares the par value of which shall be five dollars each.

Inconsistent acts sepealed. SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts, inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its approval by the governor.
