Chapter 287.

Resolves providing for a public printer.

Resolved, That the "Age," a newspaper printed at Augusta, be, and the same is hereby declared to be the public newspaper in this state, in which shall be published the laws and resolves of a public nature; and also all advertisements, notices, and orders required by law to be published in the public newspaper of the printer to the state.

Age, state paper.

Resolved, That all resolves, or parts of resolves, inconsistent herewith, be, and the same are hereby repealed; provided, that the "Kennebec Journal" shall be continued a public newspaper so long as may be necessary to complete the publication of any order or notice already inserted in said paper, and for no other purpose.

Inconsistent resolves, repealed. Proviso.

Resolved, That these resolves shall take effect from and after their approval by the governor.
