Chapter 303.

Resolve for the payment of roll of accounts number thirty-six.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of any money in the treasury of state, not otherwise appropriated, to the several persons, towns and plantations respectively named in roll of accounts numbered thirty-six, the sum set against the names of such persons, towns and plantations, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of three thousand six hundred twenty-seven dollars and sixty-nine cents, in full discharge of all the claims and demands to which they severally refer.
