#### Chapter 320.

Resolves authorizing a loan in behalf of the state.

Resolved, That the treasurer of the state is hereby author- Loan of \$30,000 ized to procure on the faith of the state, a loan of fifty thousand dollars, at a rate of interest not exceeding six per cent. per Rate of interest. annum; the principal and interest to be made payable at the when payable. city of Boston; and the treasurer is directed to issue bonds Bonds, therefor in sums not less than one thousand dollars each, with coupons attached for the payment of interest; each bond to be -how executed. signed by the treasurer, countersigned by the governor, and attested by the secretary of state, with the seal of the state; but the coupons to be signed by the treasurer only. The bonds and coupons to be all dated May first, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six.
