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**Chapter 391.**

**CHAP. 391.**

Resolve in favor of William L. Putnam.

*Resolved,* That there be paid from the treasury to William L. Putnam, the sum of thirty-two dollars, for additional services as clerk pro tempore of the house of representatives.

**Chapter 392.**

Resolve fixing the compensation of the superintendent of public buildings.

*Resolved,* That the compensation of the superintendent of public buildings for his services be, and the same is hereby fixed at one dollar and twenty-five cents per day, and that he shall not be entitled to receive any commission upon moneys by him disbursed.

**Chapter 393.**

Resolve to authorize the printing of the journal of the Constitutional Convention.

*Resolved,* That the secretary of state be directed to cause one thousand copies to be printed, of the journal of the convention which framed the Constitution of Maine.

Journal of the constitutional convention, printing of, authorized.

*Resolved,* That copies of the same be transmitted to such persons and corporations as are entitled under existing resolves to receive copies of the laws of the state, and that the remainder be retained for the future disposition of the legislature.

**Chapter 394.**

Resolve in favor of Otis Turner.

*Resolved,* That there be paid to Otis Turner from the treasury the sum of six dollars, for his services as doorkeeper during the joint hearing.
